OVERVIEW & BUSINESS NEEDS

The Client is one of the largest non-profit service providers, which provides home and community-based services to people who have developmental and/or physical disabilities, as well as those challenged by substance abuse, premature birth, child abuse/neglect, and social or economic deprivation.

The Client presented the following business needs to RSI:

- Up-gradation of the existing public and intranet portal
- Management of the existing paper work process through CMS features that encompassed document management, records management, time tracking, workflows, notifications, electronic input forms and GUI reports
- Integration with existing applications like: Kronos, MS Great Plains and ADP Payroll

CHALLENGES

Following were the challenges that the Client faced on their current website:

- Interface design and navigation was not user friendly
- Dissemination of applications and disparate data elements
- CMS with limited functionality
